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## THE POOPER HEROES

## A FUN FAMILY CARD GAME NOT FOR STRICT PARENTS BECAUSE THEY MIGHT GET POOPED ON

In this game every card can turn into poop, and if that happens, you won't want to keep them in your hand, so you'll put them on the table in front of you. That will be your poop pile and your goal is to have the smallest pile by the end of the game.

#### 1. SET UP

Remove the 4 Scoop a Poop cards from the deck as you will not use them in Happy Nappy. Shuffle the deck and deal 3 cards to each player. Leave one food card face up on the table. This will be the discard pile. The rest of the cards stay face down next to it forming the draw pile.

Now pick a player to go first (for example: the youngest player or the player who most recently went to the toilet). Afterwards, players then take turns in clockwise order.



## 2. TAKING TURNS

#### 2.1 PLAY A CARD.

On each turn you have to play one card by placing it face up on the top of the discard pile, except for the Poop card which you place on top of another player's poop pile. (see section 'ACTION CARDS EXPLAINED' on the next page)

You can play a food card if its colour or its picture matches with the colour or picture of the card on the top of the discard pile.





You can play any matching card from your hand or you can try to play the top card from your poop pile. This is one way to reduce the number of your smelly cards.

You can play an action (white) card at any time. If you play an action card, place it first, then do the action it says.



# 2.2 IF YOU HAVE NO CARDS TO PLAY, TAKE FROM THE DRAW PILE.

If you can't play the top card from your poop pile or any other cards from your hand, draw cards from the draw pile. You can choose to draw cards even if you have good cards in your hand, as you may want to keep them for later.

If you draw a card, play it immediately if possible, and then your turn is over.

If you can't play the card you've drawn, then it turns into poop. Place the card face up on the table in front of you. This will be your poop pile. Draw another card. If that one also turns into poop, place it face up on top of your poop pile: keep drawing until you find the right card to play and you can finish your turn.



### 2.3 DON'T REMAIN EMPTY-HANDED.

If, by the end of your turn, you have run out of all 3 cards in your hand, draw 3 new ones from the top of the draw pile. (If you still have at least one card in your hand, you should not draw.)

## 3. THE END OF THE GAME

The game ends when there are no more cards in the draw pile. Then all players discard the cards from their hands and count the cards in their poop piles. The player with the fewest cards wins the game.

## HOW TO PLAY POOPER LOOPER

#### 1. SET UP

Remove Poop cards from the deck until there is 1 more than the number of people playing. For example, in a 4 player game, remove 3 Poop cards, leaving 5 of them in the deck. Then shuffle the deck and deal 3 cards to each player. Leave one food card face up on the table. This will be the discard pile. The rest of the cards stay face down next to it forming the draw pile. Now pick a player to go first (for example: the youngest player or the player who most recently went to the toilet). Afterwards, players then take turns in clockwise order.

#### 2. TAKING TURNS

#### 2.1 PLAY A CARD.

See section 1 in the rules for HAPPY NAPPY. However, in POOPER LOOPER you can create a loop of cards by combining the top card of your poop pile with the cards in your hand, and you can play as many cards in one turn as possible.









# 2.2 IF YOU HAVE NO CARDS TO PLAY, TAKE FROM THE DRAW PILE.

See section 2 in the rules for **HAPPY NAPPY**.
Important! Once you draw a card from the draw pile you

are no longer allowed to loop your cards: you can only play the one card you have just drawn.

#### 2.3 DON'T REMAIN EMPTY HANDED.

See section 3 in the rules for HAPPY NAPPY.

#### 3. THE END OF THE GAME

The game ends when there are no more cards in the draw pile. Then all players discard the cards from their hands and count the cards in their poop piles. The player with the fewest cards wins the game. If there are multiple winnners, you can celebrate together.

## **ACTION CARDS EXPLAINED**



## LOLLIPOOP (4 CARDS)

Action: change colour

To play: place it on the discard pile and choose a colour from orange, red, blue, yellow or green What you can play on top of it: any food card of the colour you chose or any action card.



#### THE FLUSH (2 CARDS)

Action: discard 5 poop cards

To play: place it on the discard pile and then discard the top five cards from your poop pile by placing them on the discard pile.

What you can play on top of it: any card.



#### POOPERMAN (2 CARDS)

**Action:** give 5 of your poop cards to another player

To play: place it on the discard pile and then give the top five cards from your poop pile to one of your opponents. You choose who gets your poop cards.

What you can play on top of it: any card.



#### POOP (8 CARDS)

**Action:** dish out 4 poop cards to someone **To play:** choose a player to punish and place the Poop card on the top of their poop pile. Then draw four more cards from the draw pile and also place them face up on top of that player's poop pile.

What you can play on top of it: any card.



## SCOOP A POOP (4 CARDS)

**Action:** Scoop one previously pooped card into your hand

To play: place it on the discard pile then choose between the discard pile or one of the poop piles on the table. You can get a card of your choice from that pile and place it in your hand. What you can play on top of it: any food card with matching picture or any action card.
